

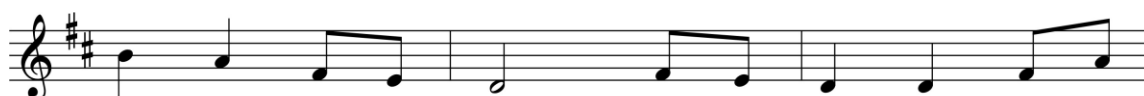

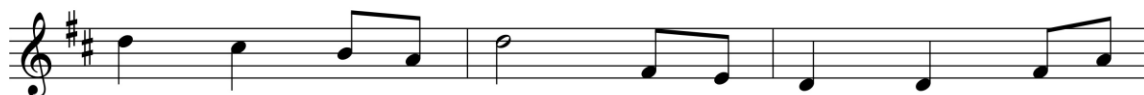

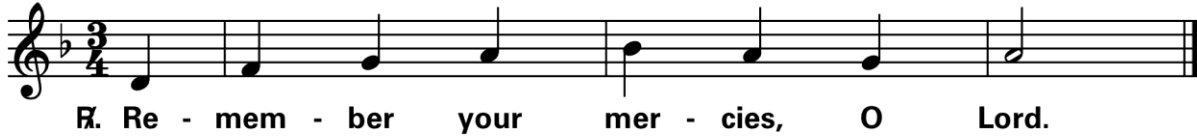

thrust into hell Satan, and all the evil spirits,

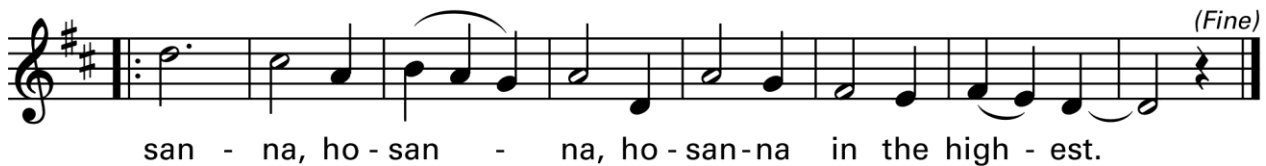
who prowl about the world seeking the ruin of souls. Amen.
