Lamb of God

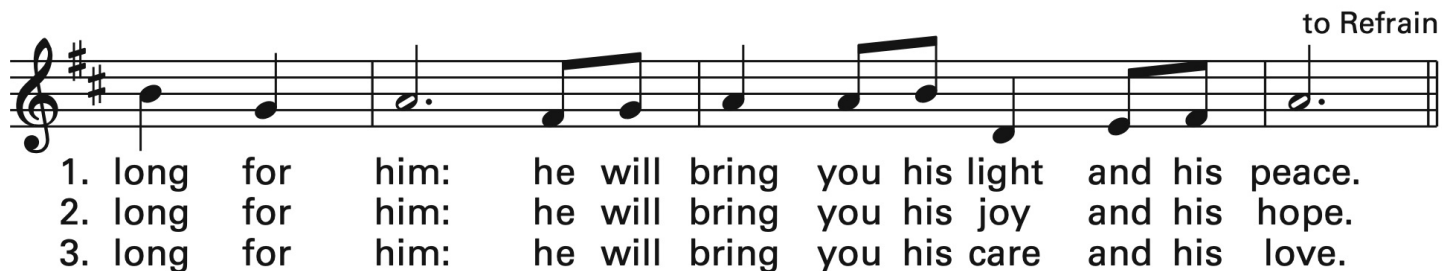
